- 2. In terms of the decision of the Board of Directors at its meeting held on November 13, 2019, it has been decided to increase the limit for hospitalization expenses from the exiting ₹5 lakhs to ₹15 lakhs per member (including spouse and dependent children) throughout the life of the Scheme. The charges for hospitalization would be recurring expenses and would be based on actual claims. For ex-employees who have already claimed ₹5 lakhs under hospitalization, differential amount would be payable to them. However, in case husband and wife are members of the Scheme, each one of them will be entitled for reimbursement of ordinary/routine medical expenses as prescribed under the Scheme.
- 3. Except as indicated above, the other provisions of VWS will remain unchanged.
- 4. The above amendment shall come into effect from November 13, 2019.
